Cleaning Products should be flushed with clean water and then washed with a mild detergent solution using a bristle brush or sponge. Care should be taken not to apply undue pressure that may damage labels. Flush clean with water after washing.










Tools Chalk, Hammer drill, 12mm masonry drill bit, Mallet, 17mm spanner





Marking out holes




Position the body in the required location and orientation, mark through the holes in the base to the ground below




Check - if fixing to pavement check that the hole positions are not too close to the edge of the paving slab (min 100mm from edge if possible)



Remove the body to expose the ground below, clearly mark the positions of the four holes with a cross









Drill 12mm holes at the four marked positions to a depth of 115mm to accommodate the ground fixing bolts.



Add washer. Push bolts through holes in base locating into drilled ground holes.



Use a mallet to drive the four bolts into the ground fixing holes, through the moulded holes in the base.

Tightening bolts



Drive the bolts in through the moulded holes unril the tops sit flat on the bin base with the washer between the bolt head and bin.



Use a spanner or socket to tighten the bolts.




Tighten the bolts to 22.0Nm torque for concrete. Tightening the bolts will fan out the bolt sheath holding the bolt secure.

Ballast filling



Once all bolts are tightened and secure close the door.



Remove bottom cap and pour gravel into hole Clear the hole of gravel so that the gravel level is 20mm from the top of the surface to accomo-date the ballast cap.
