Cleaning Products should be flushed with clean water and then washed with a mild detergent solution using a bristle brush or sponge. Care should be taken not to apply undue pressure that may damage labels. Flush clean with water after washing.

PPE Always wear appropriate PPE equipment and follow safety guidelines.

Unlocking and opening door



1 Turn key clockwise until it stops, hold key in stop position



2 With key turned grip under front panel and lift bin door upward until it stops. Remove key



3 Pivot the door open. Once opened the door will rest in lifted position on the moulded support

Envirobank can be supplied with either a single wheeled liner a split wheeled liner or sack retention

NOTE:
Leaffield does not operate a refuse collection system. This must be arranged by the customer.

Removing liner



Grip liner by handle and tilt away from bin pivoting on liner wheels



Remove the liner from bin body supporting weight on wheels



Roll liner free from bin and empty

Replacing liner and locking door



Replace liner rolling over lip on base, ensuring handle is facing outwards



Ensure liner is flat and stable on bin base before pushing door closed



When at closed position door will drop down and engage lock automatically

Sack retention variant



Feed sack through retention frame and pull down so that the open end meets the frame



Stretch the sack over the frame ensuring the sack is taut and overlapping on all edges



To release sack from retention frame. Drop down and gather liner, remove liner from bin body and dispose.
