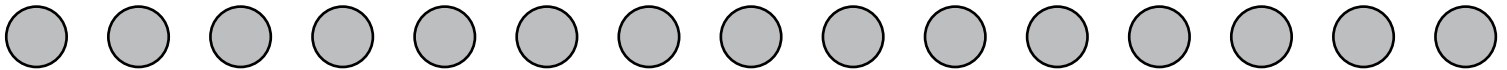

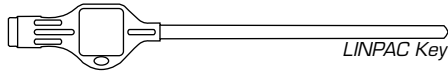
Leaffield recycling products



Cleaning Products should be rinsed with clean water and then washed with a mild detergent solution using a bristle brush or sponge. Care should be taken not to apply undue pressure that may damage labels. Flush clean with water after washing.

Removing the lid



1 Using the key provided release the lock plunger.



2 Lift the front of the lid until it is clear of the top of the bin body.



3 With one hand at the back of the bin push the lid towards the back and lift away.

Please Note: Leaffield does not operate a refuse collection system. This must be organised by the customer.

Adding a refuse bag



While pushing the lid backwards lift upwards to release the back catches.



Place a bag in the bin and stretch over the aperture.

Replacing the lid



To replace the lid first take note of the moulded hooks on the back of the lid...



...and the metal brackets on the back of the bin body.



Lower the back of the lid so the catches engage with the metal brackets.

Locking the bin



Lower the front of the lid onto the bin base.



Push in the plunge lock to engage and secure the lid.
